

# Sophie's AG Doll Sock Tutorial

**This assumes you know how to sew knit fabric.**

Turn your sock inside out.



Mark a line down to fold line to the length you want. I just eyeball it to between 1 1/2 and 2 inches.

Mark curved lines from the edge to the center line.



Sew next to the line. I start at the edge, stitch to the center line and up.

A plastic foot and paper under the fabric help the knit to feed. You can use stabilizer also but I didn't have any but had lots of scrap paper.



Here's what it looks like. Sorry about the fuzzy image.

Obviously I didn't get real picky about the stitching.



Cut between the stitching and across to the edges.



Turn them right side out.

Voila, a pair of doll socks.
